How to apply

- a) Make sure you are eligible and you accept the terms of agreement!
- b) Write the essay!
- c) Send the following items to the jordancontest@mytaiwan.hu e-mail address:
 - Scanned file of signed application form
 - Your essay (acceptable formats: docx, doc, rtf, odt)
 - Scanned file of student ID (both sides)

Formal requirements

- The essay is written in Hungarian *or* English.
- 2000-3000 words, file format: : docx, doc, rtf, odt.
- Main text: 12 pt, Times New Romano or Calibri font, 1.5 line
- Spacing: justified.
- References: footnote 10 pt, Times New Romano or Calibri, justified, single spaced.
- Bibliography and / or reading list, which is not part of the essay's main text.

Additional information

- The prizes are gross sum. The organizer will not cover extra fees if taxes or dues will be related to the prizes.
- By entering the contest, the participants agree to render the copyright to the organizer. The Taiwan Alumni Association may publish or use the essays without further request of approval.

Essay Contest Judging Criteria

- a) Understanding of the topic: clear, logical, and well-focused.
- b) Original thinking.
- c) References: Multiple references and citations are used in providing detail and supporting information about topic or time period.
- d) Organization: well organized; clear introduction, discussion, and conclusion. Many supporting details.
- e) Mechanics: Few or no grammar, spelling, punctuation, or capitalization errors. Word choice appropriate and varied.
- f) Form: All requested guidelines followed
- g) Creativity.
